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Before the Council begins reviewing the 2022 budget in detail, it would be helpful to have a sense of the Council's overall priorities for 2022.

Here are some items for the Council to consider:

- The City's tax capacity has increased by \$582,739 from last year, which means the City will have some ability to increase expenses without impacting the tax rate. The exact budget impact will be calculated by the finance director.
- Excelsior's share of the proposed Excelsior Fire District's budget is increasing by \$16,854 which equates roughly to a 1.3% levy increase.
- The South Lake Minnetonka Police Department has yet to release a preliminary budget, but their average increase is 4% annually. If their 2022 budget follows a similar trend, Excelsior's share of the budget will increase by roughly \$29,000 which equates roughly to a 2.2% levy increase.
- In past meetings, the Council has expressed an interest in adding some positions, such as a compliance officer, a master gardener, and a public works maintenance worker. Staff is also studying whether the Heritage Preservation Commission should be staffed with a separate consultant and attorney that specialize in preservation. The Council may want to discuss what positions, if any, they want to consider adding in 2022.

The Council should be prepared to share what items they want to explore including in the 2022 budget. Staff can then research the financial implications of each item for the Council to consider as part of the budget process.
